GUIDELINES ON THE USE OF THE NATIONAL ANTHEM VIDEOS

	Titled "Onward (<i>Majulah</i>)", this film instills national pride and inspires Singaporeans to move forward as one, reaching even greater heights.

- If the National Anthem video is to be used on a daily basis, users may consider playing each version of the film on alternate days.
