Terms and Conditions for National Day Colouring Competition 2020: The Padang of Singapore

- 1. The competition is open to children in three age categories: 6 years and below; 7 9 years; and 10 13 years, as of 31 Dec 2020.
 - a. Younger children (9 years and below) will be given a second template containing images from the original painting. They can cut out the images from that template, colour and paste the images on their template of the Padang if they wish.
 - b. Older children (10 13 years) are invited to use their imagination to draw and colour how they wish the Padang would look like in future.
 - c. All artists should decorate the frame around the painting.
- 2. Participants may submit more than one entry, but only one prize will be awarded to any one participant.
- 3. Participants should use only dry mediums (i.e. pencils, colour pencils, markers and crayons) for this colouring competition. Digital colouring is not allowed.
- 4. All submissions must be received by 11.59pm on 1 Aug 2020.
- 5. Participants may take a picture or scan their artwork to submit their entry. However, the file size must not exceed 7 MB, and only pdf and jpg file extension formats will be accepted.
- 6. The judges' decision is final. No correspondence will be entertained.
- 7. The National Museum of Singapore has the right to use, display or publish any of the artworks submitted.
- 8. Depending on the latest COVID-19 guidelines, the winners will be announced on National Day, 9 August 2020, either online or in a prize presentation at the National Museum of Singapore with representatives from STAEDTLER.
